A New Start for 2023

Barton Kizer*

In January of this year, I began a new work alongside Great Cities Missions, as their Director of Special Projects. I'll be working closely alongside Executive Director Kelley Grant to develop specific areas of the work, including:

- Survey the more than 30 church plants that GCM has been a part of over the last 47 years
- Gather data to be able to understand what's been going on
- Use the info to help future church plants. Serve the established church plants that are either stuck or in crisis



I started off 2023 with a trip to Panama with John Henry, a member of the Salem Church of Christ. John and his wife lived in Panama for several years, and he has long been involved in the work there. After landing in Panama City, we made the long trek to rural southern Panama, to the region known as the Darién, which borders Colombia.

Encouraging Christians in rural Panama, A chaotic visit to Peru, and my first Staff Retreat in Texas While there, I got to know many of the church members in the area, and we visited several of them in their homes. The area is beautiful, with abundant vegetation and fruit trees everywhere. The Darién is a jungle region, and many know it for the rough and dangerous terrain that many migrants from Venezuela are traveling across in search of a better life. Some of the members there are involved in ministering to those migrants and providing medical care when needed.

During my week with the church there, I taught a seminar on what it means to be an active congregation. It was very encouraging to be with the Christians there and to see the love and connection they have with one another. Update on the Kizer family and Barton's work with Great Cities Missions When they had preached the gospel to that city and had many disciples, they returned to Lystra and to Iconium and to Antioch, strengthening the souls of the disciples, encouraging them to continue in the faith (cf. Acts 14:21, 22). There are many church plants in Colombia that could benefit from a church camp. We're in the beginning stages of developing a camp that could be used for many generations in Colombia.
