Dear Coworkers,

As promised I want to inform you as quickly as I can about my health, the political situation in Haiti and our work in general.

First I want to tell you about my health. I feel much, much better. Physically I feel pretty good and mentally, I am catching up with my doctors' promise that I will get much better in a few months.

Last year was without a doubt the worst year of my life. I am glad that things do look up for me.

But the political situation in Haiti pains me so much that honestly I don 't know which is worse, my personal health or the current violence in the country. There are daily shootings, kidnappings, murders and carjackings among many violent acts. Those Haitians, among them many of our brethren who have nicer homes are told to give up their homes or be killed. Several of our brethren in the capital had to leave everything and go into hiding. So far no physical harm among our brethren is being reported. Oddly enough, none of our members have been killed. Or, we Christians want to believe God 's Hand is keeping our brethren safe.
